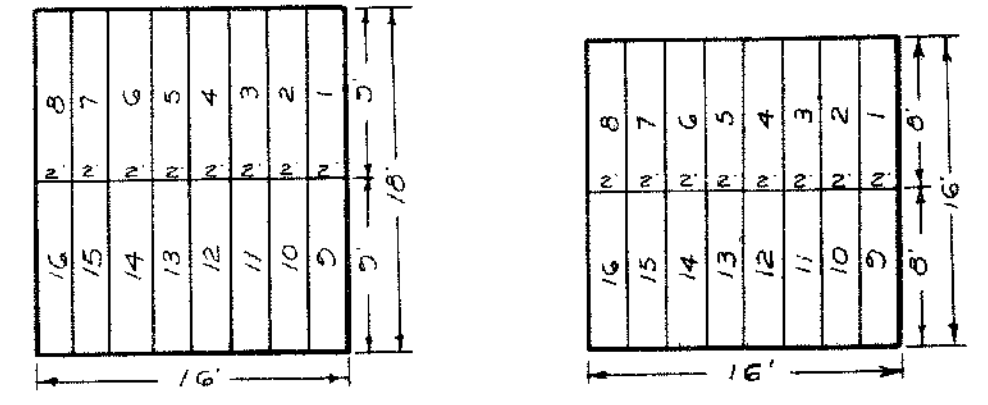


PROPERTY

Horizontal columns called Ranges are numbered 1 to 20. Ranges are subdivided into Plots lettered B to CC, J being omitted. The remaining Plots are not designated by a Range but are numbered 2 to 151, C, and D.  
Vault sites are numbered 1, 3, 4, 5, 8 to 12, 14, 14A, 14B, 16 to 32, 63 to 72, 75, 76, A, B, and E to O.

Plots in Ranges 1 to 20, and plots numbered 2 to 20 are subdivided into graves as in the following diagrams, with the exception of the graves in some of the fractional plots which do not conform with the standard but are numbered as indicated on the map.



In Plots C and D, each grave measures 5' by 2'6".  
In Plots 100 to 125 inclusive, each grave measures 10' by 3'0".  
In Plots 126 to 164 inclusive, each grave measures 5' by 3'0".

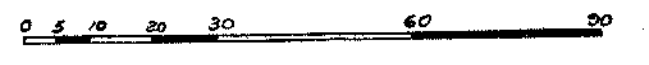
